New developments on the market this week

Landmark Pinnacle, Canary Wharf

You'll be breaking records by buying an apartment in this 75 storey skyscraper, which claims to be the tallest residential tower in London. It also has the highest residential gym, roof terrace and a landscaped garden square halfway up. These are the last homes to go on sale, offering studio to three bedroom apartments and a collection of penthouses. The scheme holds 752 residences in total, with views of the River Thames and Canary Wharf, across three buildings designed by the architects behind the new One Tower Bridge project on the South Bank. First completions are expected in autumn 2020.

Mulberry Views, Ealing

These characterful apartments in west London are ideally positioned to make the most out of London's newest high speed rail service. Crossrail, or the Elizabeth Line as it's been renamed, will be running from nearby Ealing Broadway station from 2019, dramatically shortening journeys to Heathrow. The greenery of Ealing Common is also a 15 min walk away from these nine homes, all with either one or two bedrooms, in a converted period property on Gunnersbury Avenue with communal gardens.

Get onto the property ladder on the banks of the River Thames with these new homes available to part-buy part-rent via the Shared Ownership scheme. There are 42 one and two bedroom apartments on sale as part of the affordability scheme, most with balconies but all with access to the underground car park and communal terrace. The Jubilee Line at North Greenwich will whisk commuters to Waterloo and Bond Street in 20 mins with the Thames Clipper boats and the Emirates Air Line cable car also nearby.

Expansive family houses are on sale in south west London. Boasting over 3,000sqft of space and five bedrooms over four floors, these new build properties have been inspired by Georgian period architecture, with brick facades and sash windows. Luxurious master bedroom suites, private gardens and terraces are all included as well as an integral double garage. Have royalty for neighbours with these new homes being built overlooking Kensington Palace. Less than 400m from the royal residence, this £450m development is part of the regeneration of the Queensway in Bayswater Village. There are 57 one to five bedroom apartments being built, alongside 30,000sqft of office space and new retail. There will also be a number of duplex penthouses costing up to £30m. Construction starts on the scheme this October and is expected to take three years to complete.
