#### West Sussex £4.95m

Less low-key rustic, more state-of-the-art pleasure palace, the Chantry, at the foot of the South Downs, has been stylishly remodelled by its owners, who bought it for £2.4m in 2007. The nine-bedroom period home has flowing living spaces with elegant archways, a pale grey chandelier-lit dining room, a wine cellar and a "man cave" with mirrors on the dark walls. ## London E14, from £425,000


For those who need a vertigo-inducing view to know they are living in a city, the glass-clad Landmark Pinnacle, in Canary Wharf, shouldn't disappoint. A new 784ft tower on the South Dock, designed by Squire & Partners, it will have 752 flats, with studios starting at £425,000 and one-, two- and three-bedders running from £530,000 to £1.55m; prices for the penthouses have yet to be confirmed. ### Northumberland £1.2m

Giving the Northumberland barn a fresh spin, newly built West Glade, in Riding Mill, 3½ miles from Corbridge, blends local stone and timber cladding with huge glass panels framing rural views. Entertaining on a grand scale is clearly expected here — though there are separate cosier spaces to which wallflowers can escape. #### South Lanarkshire £150,000

The 18th-century mill village of New Lanark was transformed into a model community by the utopian socialist Robert Owen. Set in a picturesque landscape near the Falls of Clyde, an hour's drive from Glasgow and Edinburgh, it's now a Unesco World Heritage Site. Eight A-listed four-storey townhouses on Double Row have been restored externally — one is being retained by the New Lanark Trust, but the others are ready to welcome modern utopians.
